- Student must have been primarily educated in the home for a total of at least five years (only three of which must be consecutive) during the time period from age four to age eighteen, OR be a member of a home education organization such as UHEA
- The Essay should be a maximum of 4 pages.
- The topic is "How I Overcame a Trial in My Life, and How I am Using that Experience for Further Success"
- All essays should be emailed to our firm at Nadean@pearsonbutler.com, with "Scholarship Essay" in the subject line

- Include a copy of your student transcript. Note: GPA is not a factor in this award.
- The firm's partners will vote for the most meaningful essay.
- The student must be a Utah resident
- There is no age limit
- Deadline to receive essays is August 31, 2017
